

Medical Release Form

It is the general policy of the Garden State Skating Club to not offer reimbursement for any contracted ice time the skater has missed. However, the club does recognize that an unexpected long-term condition involving the skater may require a special case-by-case consideration for a partial refund of ice fees.

General Guidelines

- The skater is in good standing with the club
- Skater must have missed all their skating sessions for three consecutive weeks because of an unexpected medical condition
- Any request for a refund is accompanied by a note from the doctor treating the medical condition, describing the condition affecting the skater's inability to skate
- Complete and submit the Medical Release Form below with the attached doctor's note
- All requests are subject to board review (allow 4-6 weeks)
- Upon approval the skater will be issued passes for the approved number of missed sessions minus one session. The passes will good for a 3-month period upon the skaters return to the ice.
